Good Friday: A Day of Fasting, Abstinence, and Grace

As we journey through Holy Week, we are reminded that **Good Friday** is a solemn day of reflection and reverence. In accordance with Church teaching:

- **Good Friday is a day of both fasting and abstinence.**
- **Fasting** (for those aged 18–59) means one full meal and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal.
- **Abstinence** (for those aged 14 and older) means refraining from eating meat

These practices unite us with the suffering and sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross, and they prepare our hearts for the joy of the Resurrection.



Easter Food Blessing - Holy Saturday, 19th April at 11am
Join us on **Holy Saturday** for the **Blessing of Easter Food** - a beautiful tradition symbolizing gratitude, renewal, and the joy of the Resurrection. Families are invited to bring baskets of food to be blessed as we prepare to celebrate Easter together in faith and hope.

Vigil Candles Part of our Easter tradition is the candles for the Easter Vigil to signify that Christ the light of the world has won victory over death and darkness. LED Candles for the 6pm Easter Vigil will be available at the entry doors, **we would be grateful for a gold coin donation to cover the cost.**

Divine Mercy Novena & Sunday Celebration – 27th April

We will begin the **Divine Mercy Novena** on **Good Friday**, following Jesus' request to St. Faustina, as recorded in her diary. This nine-day devotion is a time of deep prayer and reflection, leading us to the celebration of **Divine Mercy Sunday** - a special opportunity to receive God's grace and mercy.

We warmly invite you to join us each day of the novena as we prepare our hearts to receive the abundant mercy flowing from the Heart of Jesus.

A **plenary indulgence** is granted to those who devoutly participate in the **3pm Divine Mercy Hour** on Divine Mercy Sunday, under the usual conditions (Confession, Holy Communion, prayer for the Pope's intentions, and freedom from attachment to sin).

Join us at **3pm for Mass**, followed by the **Hour of Mercy and Adoration**.



The Divine Mercy Novena Good Friday - Divine Mercy Sunday

Today bring to Me all mankind, especially sinners and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. In this way you will console Me in the bitter grief into which the loss of souls plunges Me.

Receive us all into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart, and never let us escape from It. We beg this of You by Your love which unites You to the Father and the Holy Spirit. Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon all mankind and especially upon poor sinners, all enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus.
