Invitation to the Monthly Santo Niño Mass

You are invited to join us in celebrating the **Monthly Santo Niño Mass on Friday, 27th March**. The Holy Mass will begin at 7pm, followed by the Litany to the Holy Señor Santo Niño.

Palm Sunday - Hosanna!

Hosanna! Today we join the crowds in welcoming Jesus into Jerusalem, laying down palms and shouting praise. "Hosanna" means "Save us, Lord!" - a heartfelt cry of hope, surrender, and trust in God's mercy.

Did you know that the Church traces the tradition of blessing palms back to the 4th century in Jerusalem?

Carrying and venerating palms is not just symbolic—it reminds us that we are participants in Christ's triumphal entry and His mission of salvation. Each time we pray with the palms in hand, we are called to invite Jesus into our daily lives, bringing Him into our work, our struggles, and our joys.

Holding a palm, you might pray:

"Lord, help me welcome You into my heart today, and strengthen me to follow You faithfully through all life's challenges."



Special Plenary Indulgences During Holy Week

A plenary indulgence is a special grace given by the Church that removes all temporal punishment due to sin (*the lingering effects or consequences of sin that remain even after forgiveness*). A partial indulgence removes part of this temporal punishment. While Confession forgives the guilt of sin, indulgences help to heal and purify the soul. A plenary indulgence is "full," restoring the soul completely in this respect, while a partial indulgence is "partial," remitting only part of that purification.

Make this Holy Week truly meaningful by taking part in the Church's most sacred liturgies and devotions.

You are encouraged to:

Attend the major Holy Week liturgies:

- ◆ Holy Thursday (Mass of the Lord's Supper)
- ◆ Good Friday (Passion of the Lord)
- ◆ Easter Vigil

Spend time in prayer and devotion:

- ◆ Eucharistic Adoration (especially after Holy Thursday Mass)
- ◆ Pray the Stations of the Cross
- ◆ Venerate the Cross on Good Friday
- ◆ Renew your baptismal promises at the Easter Vigil

To receive a plenary indulgence, also complete the following:

- ◆ Go to Confession (within about 20 days before or after)
- ◆ Receive Holy Communion
- ◆ Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (e.g. Our Father, Hail Mary)
- ◆ Be free from attachment to sin (have a sincere heart turned toward God)

Let us not miss this powerful opportunity for grace. Make time this week for Mass, Confession, Adoration, and prayer, and allow the Lord to renew your heart.



SECOND RITE OF RECONCILIATION


