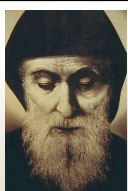

**Supporting Our Parish - Your family**  
Your generous contributions through Planned Giving envelopes, cash donations during Mass, and Tap-and-Go donations form the Parish Collection. These funds are essential for the day-to-day running of our parish and enable us to continue our pastoral, spiritual, and community ministries. Parish income is used to meet all operating expenses, including:

- Administration and office costs
- Insurance premiums
- Electricity, water, gas, and other utilities
- Salaries for parish staff
- Priests' vehicle and travel expenses
- Guest Speakers and Visiting priests
- Sacramental and Faith Formation programs
- Maintenance and repairs of all parish properties, including churches, parish halls, presbyteries, convents, and parish offices


Our parish is responsible for meeting all of these expenses from its own income. Parish funds cannot be supplemented from other sources to cover everyday operating costs. In addition, if the annual contribution required by the Archdiocese for the Charitable Works Fund (CWF) is not fully achieved, the remaining balance must be paid from parish funds. As our parish has not reached the CWF target in recent years, part of the Parish Collection has been used to cover this shortfall.
